Students were introduced to their

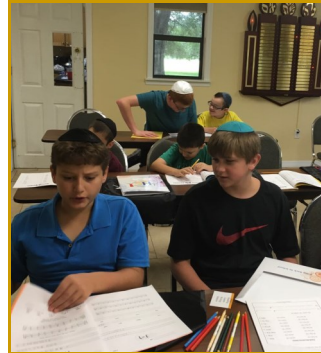
Curriculums, each one with a special year long project and incentive program.
