MESSAGE FROM THE RABBI



On the ninth day of the month of Av ("Tisha B'Av") we fast and mourn the destruction of

the Holy Temple in Jerusalem. Both the first Temple (833–423 BCE) and the second Temple (349 BCE–69 CE) were destroyed on this date.

We have just fasted and mourned the destruction of the Temple on the 9th of Av, corresponding this year to Sunday, July 26.

The Shabbat preceding the fast day is called the "Shabbat of Vision." On this Shabbat, we read a chapter from the Prophets that begins, "The vision of Isaiah." The prophecy of Isaiah is dismal, where Isaiah foresees the destruction of the Temple.

Rabbi Levi Yitzchok of Berditchev, famed Chasidic master, explains this concept with a parable:

A father prepares a beautiful suit of clothes for his son. But the child neglects

his father's gift, and soon the suit is in tatters. The father gives the child a second suit of clothes; this one, too, is ruined by the child's carelessness. So, the father makes a third suit. This time, however, he withholds it from his son.

Every once in a while, on special and opportune times, he shows the suit to the child, explaining that when the child learns to appreciate and properly care for the gift, it will be given to him. This induces the child to improve his behavior, until it gradually becomes second nature to him—at which time he will be worthy of his father's gift.

On Shabbat Chazon, we are given a vision of the third Holy Temple that will be rebuilt in the future. It is not a vision that our eyes physically see, rather a vision that our souls experience.

Although we do not physically see this vision, it evokes inspiration and it demands a response from us.

A runner before a race visualizes the finish line and the energy he will feel upon completing the race. When he nears the finish line, his previous visualization gives him the extra boost to cross over that finish line no matter how tired he is.

Since we have just experienced such an incredible vision, one that's imprinted on our subconscious, on our souls; we have the power to be in tune with our soul's vision and use this inspiration to reach the finish line, the Final Redemption.

We do this by performing acts of goodness of kindness thus hastening the Final Redemption when all of mankind will be at peace and the wisdom of G-d will fill the world.

May our souls' vision empower us to fulfill our mission of making this world a dwelling place for G-d by building His Holy House, the Temple, speedily in our days.


